

Let's Play!

Commandments on the Line

- Gather 10 socks, preferably adult-size, calf-length tube socks.
- Cut 10 one-inch pieces of masking tape and number each piece from 1 to 10. Place one on each sock.
- Tie a string about 6 feet long between two chairs, then move them apart until the string is taut.
- Time each round with a clock, stopwatch or timer app.


Start the timer. Players stand near the pile of numbered socks, about 8 feet from the rope. The first player chooses any sock, recites the commandment with the same number, then tries to toss the sock onto the rope. Players take turns, continuing until all socks are tossed. Younger children may stand closer to the rope. Once all 10 socks are thrown, stop the timer and count the socks on the line for the score. Play again to beat the first time and score.

THE TEN COMMANDMENTS

- You must not have any other god but Me.
- 2. You must not make for yourself an idol of any kind.
- 3. You must not misuse the name of the LORD your God.
- 4. Observe the Sabbath day by keeping it holy.
- 5. Honor your father and mother.

- 9. You must not testify falsely against your neighbor.
- 10. You must not covet ... anything ... that belongs to your neighbor.




Ten Commandments Wheel




A Giant Adventure Flip Book




Explore Creation Telescope


The Armor of God

The Israelite troops wore armor to protect themselves. Did you know that God gives us invisible armor to wear? Let's read about it in the Bible. Read Ephesians 6:10-18.

Create, label and decorate each piece of the armor of God for each child to wear by using household objects or simple craft materials. Race to see who can put on all of the armor first!

- · Belt of Truth: long strip of cloth or scarf.
- Breastplate of Righteousness: large paper bag slit down the back, with holes for head and arms.
- · Shoes of Peace: pieces of felt cut to fit over feet.
- · Shield of Faith: large piece of cardboard.
- · Helmet of Salvation: plastic bowl.
- · Sword of the Spirit: long piece of cardboard.

Afterwards, discuss each piece of armor. Ask the children to think of a situation where they might have to use it. Then when they need their spiritual armor in real life, it will be easy for them to imagine putting it on.



Let's Play!

Build a Pyramid

Did you know that the pyramids were already very old when the Israelites were slaves in Egypt? The Great Pyramid of Giza was called one of the seven wonders of the ancient world—and it is the only one still in existence today.


Can you guess how many sides a pyramid has? It is built on a square base with four sides. Each side slopes upward in a triangular shape, meeting at the top in a point.

Race each other to build the highest pyramid you can using dominoes, small wooden blocks, or plastic bricks that snap together. Then, read Jesus' teaching in **Matthew 7:24-27** and discuss what makes a builder wise:

"Anyone who listens to my teaching and follows it is wise, like a person who builds a house on solid rock. Though the rain comes in torrents and the floodwaters rise and the winds beat against that house, it won't collapse because it is built on bedrock. But anyone who hears my teaching and doesn't obey it is foolish, like a person who builds a house on sand. When the rains and floods come and the winds beat against that house, it will collapse with a mighty crash."

Hit the Mark

Sin means to "miss the mark." But with God's help, we can "hit the mark" by obeying His Word and doing things that please Him.


You can practice "hitting the mark" in this game! You will need beanbags and a small box for a target to represent God's Word. If you don't have beanbags, they're easy to make. For each one, put about ½ cup of dried beans, uncooked rice, or unpopped popcorn into a sandwich bag and seal it shut. Place it inside another sandwich bag, seal it, and tape the top for extra strength.

Stand a few feet away from the target and take turns tossing the beanbags to see who can "Hit the Mark" the most times!


